General Information

Purpose: Chinese Christian Schools' Summer Program is designed for students wanting to develop and/or maintain skills in core subject areas.

Registration: Registration is done on a first-come, first-serve basis *by campus*. Complete the registration packet and return it to the school office along with your payment in full. After April 8th, a \$20 late registration fee will apply.

**Registration Packet includes: Registration Form, Emergency Information Form, Shuttle Request Form (if needed), Copy of latest Report Card/Progress Report.*

Attendance/Discipline: Consistent, regular attendance is required. Parents must give serious consideration to vacation plans before enrolling their child(ren) in summer session. For credit classes, no more than three absences are permitted in order to earn credit. Also, students will be expected to maintain a high level of discipline and respect in all Summer School Activities. Disruptive students will not be tolerated and may be dropped from the program.

- *No School on Monday, July 4th*

Extended Day Program: An extended day program is available for students from 3:30 PM – 6:00 PM. The cost is \$460 or \$22 per day for drop-ins. Snack is included.

Students may be dropped off in the morning as early as **7:00 AM at no additional charge.**

Class Cancellation Disclaimer: Chinese Christian Schools will make every effort to provide all the courses and services listed in this brochure. However, we reserve the right to cancel any class or service listed due to lack of enrollment or circumstances beyond our control. If such a cancellation occurs, you will be notified immediately.

Terms and Conditions: All payments are non-refundable. No pro-rating of any fees or changes can be made due to student cancellations. Payments will be refunded if Chinese Christian Schools must cancel a course or service due to lack of enrollment.

Lunch Options: All **full day** students are eligible to purchase school lunches on a weekly basis. Menus and additional information will be provided with the summer school confirmation letter.

Transportation: Complimentary shuttle service is provided between our SL and Alameda campuses before, midday, and after school at the times indicated on the form.

*** Enrollment Deadline is Friday, June 3, 2011 or when the class is full.*

Grades 1st – 5th Course Descriptions

Academic Classes (Morning Sessions)

Students will be studying grade level Math and English. The curriculum will reinforce skills learned in past years as well as introducing new skills and concepts. The goal of the academic courses are for students to practice specific skill activities through practical exercises.

English: Students will learn and practice comprehension and thinking strategies to enhance understanding and critical thinking:

- Questioning: asking questions as you read as a means of focusing one's thoughts.
- Modeling: putting into practice the values taught in the reading.
- Determining importance: prioritizing the information being presented.
- Inferring: understanding what facts, messages, and emotions are being communicated without being explicitly stated.

Math: Students will be practicing grade level appropriate math concepts and exercises. Worksheets, math manipulatives, and class discussion will cover a variety of math topics.

Enrichment Classes (Afternoon Sessions)

Students will have the opportunity to have fun while learning! Students will experience Science through a hands-on approach with our Mad Science coordinators. Arts & Crafts will provide a time to exercise their creativity and imagination through fun projects. Sports will teach them teamwork and provide the physical activity necessary for healthy living. Field trips are offered once a week.
