Course Description:

Sixth grade Mandarin class is designed to prepare students for more serious learning in the years to come.

Throughout the year, I will instruct the students in listening, speaking, reading, and writing skills.

At the end of the course, students take a placement test to determine which track they will follow in the following years. We have honor Mandarin and regular Mandarin. The more advanced students will go to the honor Mandarin.

Our course outline includes colors, clothing, weather, hobbies, academic subjects, and various conversational topics.

There will be 5 Units in the book. Each Unit will be divided into several lessons. A new lesson will be given to the class each week. 20 vocabularies will be given out each week.

Supplementary:

In addition to the textbook, we will learn Bible, singing, and famous quotations of Confucius.

Assessment:

There will be a weekly tests on oral and written test after a lesson has been taught. Besides doing the workbook, The handouts and individual or group projects will be given out frequently.

PinYin drill will be exercised through out the first and second quarters.

Memorizing Bible verses and also singing in Chinese will be part of the curriculum.
