

WELCOME TO MATH 6

Expectations: Students should be able to demonstrate their mastery of California State Content Standards for grade 6 by the end of the school year. Students will make it their goal to complete assignments and pay attention in order to maintain a healthy working environment for all. Students will be able to explain how the math concepts covered in class apply to their everyday lives. Students are expected to dedicate themselves to consistency in the pursuit of success, to seek help when necessary, and to take responsibility for their success.

Required Supplies:

- College Ruled Notebook (70 pages or more)
- Ruler (12 inch)
- Eraser
- #2 pencils (2 or more)
- Green pen for correction
- Dry erase board (Usually 8 ½"X11" in size)
- Set of dry erase markers (Black, blue, green are the recommended colors)
- Protractor and Compass

Grading:

- 50% Tests
- 30% Quizzes (chapter, homework, and notebook)
- 20% Homework and class work

(The semester grade is composed of 50% of the Quarter 1 grade and 50% of the Quarter 2 grade)

Tests and Quizzes: Tests will be given either in the middle of a chapter, at the end of the chapter, or both. Quizzes will be given usually after 3 math sections. Missed exams can be taken depending on the reasons. Students who are late are responsible for taking the test upon return. Students will automatically fail if they talk during the test. **After each test and quiz is graded, they will be sent home for parent viewing and signature.**

Homework: Homework is generally assigned daily with the exception of holidays and special events. Assignments and due dates will be posted on PowerSchool at the end of each school day. After homework is corrected in class, students are expected to make corrections on their homework that night and submit it the next day for a grade.

Homework Grading Policy: If homework is not brought to class on the due date it is considered late. Late homework will receive a grade of 70%. For each additional day late the grade will be reduced 10%.

Student accountability: Students are responsible for their own work. When absent for more than one day, he/she must check PowerSchool or contact a classmate for the assignments.
